

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

CAN OFFICIALS FROM ANY ASSOCIATION JOIN?

Absolutely - SACUSA is a state-wide organisation and any umpire or scorer in SA is eligible for membership. In fact anyone interested in the mission and vision of SACUSA can join.

WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

There are 2 levels of membership:

- Full Membership – \$110 pp/yearly
- Associate Member – \$55 pp/yearly

WHICH LEVEL OF MEMBERSHIP IS FOR ME?

Full Membership is for all active or non-active officials (i.e. current or previous Umpires & scorers) at the Premier Cricket level and above.

Associate Membership is for active officials below Premier Cricket level and non-active members or anyone who involve in the cricket community.

WHAT DO I GET FOR MY MEMBERSHIP?

Subsidies to SACUSA events including; Presentation Dinner, Bradman Rolton Medal, family fun days, social cricket matches, Easter events etc.,

- Subsidised clothing and apparel,
- Acknowledgment of career milestones & achievements,
- Monthly Newsletter,
- Umpire and Scorer Name badges,
- Annual Report,
- Free BBQ dinner at general meetings,
- Voting rights at SACUSA elections (full membership only),
- Friendly forum at which to seek advice.
